➔ Scholars Program

South Kent is seeking to establish 25 new four-five year Scholars Programs, each supported at a minimum of \$50 - \$75,000 annually (\$200K-\$300K total commitment), allowing the School to designate a Scholar in honor of a person, family, or purpose. Additional opportunities include a Half Scholars Program at \$40,000 annually and Partial Scholars Program beginning at \$25,000 annually.

These multi-year commitments provide continuity and stability for both students and the School, ensuring recipients can fully experience and benefit from their years on the Hillside.

➔ Endowed Scholarships

For those seeking to create a lasting legacy, Endowed Scholarships beginning at \$1 million provide permanent, perpetual support for future generations of South Kent students.

Through annual investment earnings, an endowed scholarship continuously supports student scholars year after year, ensuring that a donor's values, legacy, or designated purpose remain an enduring part of the South Kent experience for generations to come.

Tuition support at South Kent School ensures that talented and promising young men can access the life-changing experience of a South Kent education, regardless of financial circumstance.

Over the past two decades, more than 500 South Kent students have benefited from tuition assistance, opening the door to a community and culture shaped by the School's enduring Trinity of Values.

Anchored in the conviction that talent deserves opportunity and a route to excellence, South Kent's needs-based support model reflects the standards and practices of the nation's leading preparatory schools and colleges.
